POSSESSIVE 'S

USE

- Possessive 's is used to show ownership or possession.
- Example: *John's car* means the car belongs to John.



FORM

- As a general rule : add 's to the noun.

cat → *cat's*

- For words ending in -s: add an apostrophe after the -s.

cats → *cats'*

- ***Sarah's book is on the table.***
- ***The dog's leash is red.***
- ***The students' backpacks are in the classroom.***
